For whom	<p>This interactive conference is for cultural educators from museums, galleries and heritage sites, teachers of all levels (formal education and lifelong learning) and artists who wish to learn more about using drawing to support learning, engagement and enjoyment.</p> <p>The conference responds to growing interest in the learning potential of the Campaign's flagship programmes, The Big Draw and Power Drawing professional development, from education colleagues inside and outside the UK.</p>
Learning objectives	<p>Participants will gain:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• greater understanding of how drawing can be used for different purposes;• a wider view of drawing as a tool for learning and engagement in a variety of settings – including lifelong learning and cultural education in museums, galleries and heritage sites;• increased confidence to organise Big Draw events within her or his institution;• an opportunity to network with other European educators who would like to experiment with, and share case studies of drawing as a medium for learning, cultural and social engagement and enjoyment.
